Antistic Director Christing Wilder

Christina was born in Portland and raised in the local Vancouver area where she got her start in ballet from the Academy of Ballet Arts under the direction of Noreen Kendall. From age nine to 14, she studied Tap, Ballet, Jazz and Character. During her middle school years, Christina participated in the Vancouver Dance Theater's Nutcracker and spring shows. She attended dance camp in Walla Walla and in New York. Because of her desire to advance in the Royal Academy of Dancing syllabus, Christina joined June Taylor's School of Dance in Tigard, Oregon where she completed her Intermediate Royal Academy of Dancing examination under Tami Walker. As she prepared for her Advanced examination, Christina was in a car accident, ending any future training. With years of teaching assisting under her belt, an opportunity to teach ballet was presented. Enjoying working with dancers, Christina entered into the three-year Royal Academy of Dancing teachers training program at age 18. She traveled the US, Canada and England training with examiners from all over the world. At age 19 Christina took over Academy of Ballet Arts from her former teacher and has been running classes ever since.Christina has also trained and/or taken classes in: Pilates, child development, anatomy, early childhood dance, dance history, injury prevention classes, Vaganova syllabus, Cecchetti syllabus and dance as worship. Over the course of 30 years of teaching, students under Christina's training have gone on to have full scholarships to dance camps, colleges, professional careers and have become teachers. Christina currently lives in her home town with her husband, Aaron and three children, Emmaline, Eli and Olivia.


Jacoby Thompson

Myah Hendrickson



The Party

It's the month of December and the Stahlbaums are hosting their annual holiday party. Though the weather is harsh and the ground is covered in snow, all of their closest friends are able to make it to the party. Once all the guests have arrived, they start the party by dancing together. Even Clara's younger brother, Fritz, is having a good time. Two special guests have arrived; the uncle to Clara and Fritz, Herr Drosselmeyer and his nephew. Drosselmeyer entertains the party-goers with a magic show, Jack-in-the-Box, and life-sized dancing dolls. He presents a very special gift to Clara: a priceless wooden Nutcracker. All are in awe of the Nutcracker and continue to dance with joy. After so much excitement, Clara, Fritz and all of the guests are exhausted. The Stahlbaums' guests bid farewell, thanking them for their hospitality, and graciously thanking Herr Drosselmeyer for the evening's entertainment.

The **Battle**

It is almost midnight when Clara sneaks back into the living room to retrieve her Nutcracker from the mantel. She discovers something magical has happened. The tree towers over her while mice the size of children are wreaking havoc all over the room. Some are snatching candies from the tree while others try to steal her precious Nutcracker! Clara is defenseless and about to give up when suddenly an army of soldiers appears, led by a lifesized Nutcracker. The mice huddle in fear. Suddenly, the Mouse Queen enters the battlefield, strong and vicious. The Mouse Queen has come to save the mice and put an end to Clara and the Nutcracker. Clara watches in fear as the Nutcracker and the Mouse Queen duel. The power of the mice is overwhelming and in one final swoop the Mouse Queen renders the Nutcracker lifeless. In a burst of rage, Clara strikes the Mouse Queen in the head with a gigantic candy cane. The Mouse Queen falls to the ground and her little mice carry her away, surrendering the battle. Clara, in tears, throws herself on the ground. As her tears fall on the Nutcracker's face, he suddenly becomes a Prince! Overwhelmed with joy, Clara and the Prince dance together to celebrate their victory.

The Snow Storm

Snow flurries begin to fall and Clara's living room is transformed into a winter wonderland. A light snow becomes a blizzard and gradually settles, revealing a pathway. The Snow King and Queen arrive to guide Clara and the Prince down the path to their destination - The Land of Sweets.

The Land of Sweets comes alive as the Sugar Plum Fairy and her Cavalier watch the celebration from their throne. The Sugar Plums Pages commence the entertainment followed by cotton candy, lemon drops, mint swirls, peppermint candies, candy corns, and neapolitans. The Sugar Plum Fairy and her Cavalier greet Clara and the Prince as they join the festivities. To delight the Sugar Plum Fairy and her court, Clara and the Prince reenact the battle with the Mouse Queen. Impressed with their bravery, the Sugar Plum Fairy rewards them then performs a graceful solo for all to enjoy. As the gala continues the Sugar Plum Fairy presents Clara and the Prince with more dancing sweets from her kingdom.

Chinese Tea leaves are traditional and energetic. The Mirliton Shepherdess charmingly leads her adorable lambs. The Slovak Tea cakes are lively and brazen. Spanish Hot Chocolate is flashy and fast. Arabian coffee demonstrates patience and extraordinary skill. Mother Ginger and her children complete the cheerful show with their animated antics.

The room is then wondrously filled with flowers and petals as a single Dew Drop Fairy gracefully whirls among them. Once the flowers are done, the room quiets as the Sugar Plum Fairy is joined by her Cavalier as they come together for their magical duet enchanting everyone in the room. Clara and the Prince wonder how anything could be so beautiful. All the sweets gather for the final waltz of the evening as they wish Clara and the Prince farewell.
